RULES & REGULATIONS

The 2011 United Mountain Horse, Inc. rules will apply to each division during the World Championship

UMH MEMBERSHIP: Exhibitors, owner, lessee and trainer must be a member associate in good standing to compete in the 2011 UMH World Grand Championship Horse Show. Exhibitors must have a valid UMH Riders Card to show in any class. Memberships and Rider's Cards are available in the show office.

HORSE REGISTRATION: All horses must be registered with a Mountain Horse registry. The original or copy of the front and back of each horses' registration papers must be furnished with your entries. AGMH Registration is required for all conformation classes, the Trail Pleasure World Grand Championship (class 108), the Country Trail Pleasure World Grand Championship (class 106), the Park Pleasure World Grand Championship (class 121), and the Classic Pleasure World Grand Championship (class 120)

ENTRY DEADLINE: The pre-entry deadline is Friday, August 26, 2011. All entries must be RECEIVED by close of business on this day to qualify for the pre-entry rate. The post-entry deadline is one hour before each morning session and two hours before each evening session. There are no refunds on entries or scratches after the entry deadline for each session, unless you can present a veterinary certificate.

STALL RESERVATIONS: Stalls are \$150 per stall for the show and include first bedding (2 bags of shavings). Stall reservations can be made on your entry form or by calling the show manager, Mark Farrar, at 615-604-4616. All stalls must be paid for in advance and payments are non-refundable. Stalls must be assigned by the show manager. Stalls will be available on Sunday, September 4th. For early arrivals, please contact the show manager, 615-469-4040 or UMHWorldShow@gmail.com.

Because we are obligated to pay for stalls once we rent them, we are not able to give refunds on stall cancellations.

GROUNDS FEE: A grounds fee of \$10 per horse for the duration of the show will be charged to horses not stabled on the grounds.

SHAVINGS: Each stall includes an initial bedding of two bags of shavings. Additional bags can be pre-ordered on your entry form or in the show office each day for \$7 per bag. Shavings must be ordered by 1:00pm each day for delivery that same day.

RESERVED SEATING: Reserved seating is available on a first come, first serve basis. Covered ringside seating for four is \$100 for the show. VIP tables with 9 chairs are also available for \$300 for the show. A limited number of ringside golf cart parking spaces are available for \$200 for the show. Reserved seats, VIP tables and golf cart spaces can be reserved on your entry form .

PAYMENT OF FEES: All fees must be paid before an entry may show. A signed blank check or credit card authorization form can be left in the show office. Cash, check and credit cards are accepted.

SPLIT CLASSES: Any class with over thirty entries will be split. Other classes may be split at the discretion of show management.

WORK-OUTS: A judge may call for a work-out for any or all entries in a class. A work-out is mandatory for classes with twenty or more entries.

SPOTTED HORSES: Must be registered with ASMH or SMHA and may show in the following classes:

- Class 114 – Equitation, Youth 17 & Under

QUALIFYING FOR GRAND CHAMPIONSHIPS: To be eligible, horses must be entered, shown and judged in any class of its division. To show in an under-saddle championship, the horse must qualify in an under-saddle class in the same division. To show in an in-hand championship, the horse must qualify in an in-hand class. “Shown and judged” means completing the class to the line-up; the horse does not have to be placed in the class to qualify. Please refer to the “Class Listing by Division” for information on classes that WILL NOT qualify a horse for a championship.

In order to show in the Trail Pleasure World Grand Championship (class 108), the Country Trail Pleasure World Grand Championship (class 106), the Park Pleasure World Grand Championship (class 121), or the Classic Pleasure World Grand Championship (class 120), horses must be registered AGMH. In order to qualify for the top prize money in the class, horses must have applied for AGMH registration by July 31st and completed registration by September 5th, as well as meet all other requirements as listed in the current UMH Rule Book.

The top three horses in open classes will be required to show back in a championship class in that division or forfeit their prize money. The top three riders in youth and amateur classes will be required to show back in a championship class in that division or forfeit their prize money (they may show a different horse that was also qualified). This rule does not apply to preliminary classes where no championship is offered (i.e. Novice, Amateur Owned & Trained, Ladies Auxiliary, Trail Obstacle, etc.). Exhibitors who have more than one entry qualified for a given championship class will be allowed to choose an entry to show back and not be penalized for the others. Please refer to the Class Listing by Division for more information.

HEALTH CERTIFICATE / COGGINS: All horses must have current Coggins test papers. All out-of-state horses must have an interstate health certificate. Officials from the Kentucky Department of Agriculture will be on the show grounds to check for these papers.

PRIZE MONEY: Premium checks will be available no earlier than 30 days after the last day of the show. We must have the complete address and social security number of the person to receive the premium.

CAMPER / RV SITES: A limited number of camper and RV hookups are available for \$165 for the week. They can be reserved on a first-come, first-serve basis. Those who reserved spaces last year will receive the first opportunity to reserve that same space in 2011. All campsites include water and electric. An RV pumping service will be scheduled during the show; you can sign up for this service in the show office. Reserve camper spots on your entry form or by contacting the show manager at 615-469-4040 or UMHWorldShow@gmail.com.

INSPECTION: All horses shown must be inspected by the DQP prior to entering the show ring. All class winners must return immediately to the DQP station for a post show inspection. The DQP, USDA or show management may require a post show inspection for other horses as well. Any horse excused from the ring, either voluntarily (i.e. by the exhibitor themselves) or involuntarily (i.e. by a judge), must report to the DQP for inspection. Any horse that receives a DQP ticket for a Horse Protection Act violation will not be allowed to show for the duration of the show. Only three people are allowed in the inspection area with each horse (groom, trainer and exhibitor).

The show steward may also inspect horses for tack, attire and equipment compliance. All horses shown in the 14.3 & Under class will be measured by the steward prior to their class.

DNA AND HOOF TESTING: All horses entered in the show are subject to have their shoes removed, weighed and hoof tested. A tail hair sample may also be taken for DNA verification. This will be done in the presence of the official show veterinarian and a DQP. Winners of the Trail Pleasure World Grand Championship (class 108), the Country Trail Pleasure World Grand Championship (class 106), the Park Pleasure World Grand Championship (class 121), and the Classic Pleasure World Grand Championship (class 120) will have a shoe removed and tail hair sample taken immediately after their class. Any horse that fails these tests will be stripped of all awards won at the show and will not be allowed to show for the duration. The test results will also be shared with the United Mountain Horse Board of Directors for further disciplinary action.

CAR & TRUCK PARKING PERMITS: Weekly parking passes are available in the show office. Barn Parking permits are required for anyone parking in the barn area (behind barns 1-5). Each farm that reserves stalls will receive one free parking pass for every five stalls they reserve; additional weekly Barn Parking passes may be purchased for \$50. General Parking permits are also available for the parking area closest to the show ring. Weekly General Parking permits are \$40. Parking permits include admittance for everyone in your vehicle. Nightly General Parking passes are available for \$7 per vehicle (Mon-Wed) or \$10 per vehicle (Fri-Mon). Trucks pulling trailers are admitted for free and do not need a pass, however will be required to park in the Day Parking area.

GOLF CARTS: In order to protect our liability and your safety, all golf carts (including Gators, etc.) must purchase a permit in the show office. Permits are \$10 and you must have a valid drivers license to purchase. No one under the age of 16 is allowed to drive a golf cart or motorized vehicle on the show grounds. United Mountain Horse, Inc. and the Kentucky Equestrian Center reserve the right to impound any vehicle, including but not limited to golf carts, that is driven by someone under the age of 16. Vehicles will remain impounded until such time as the owner can remove them from the property.

A limited number of ringside golf cart parking spaces are available for \$200 for the show, the price includes the permit. Reserve your spot on your entry form or contact the show manager at 615-469-4040 or UMHWorldShow@gmail.com.

DOGS: We love dogs, but due to the difficulties and dangers imposed by virtue of the presence of dogs at horse shows, the following rules will be enforced without exception – No dogs are permitted on the show premises (grounds, barns, etc.) unless on a leash, in hand, or secured in a stall.

PARKING: In an effort to make your trip to the Kentucky Equestrian Center and the United Mountain Horse World Grand Championships an enjoyable and safe experience, the following policies will be enforced regarding parking:

After unloading, horse/tack trailers are to park in the designated Trailer Drop area. Trailers cannot be parked next to the barns, in the Barn Parking area or General Parking area. We appreciate your cooperation as we try to keep our roads and fire lanes clear and save parking spaces for cars and trucks. The trailer drop area is located along the fence row to the left of the entrance gate to the grounds (where the greenhouse was). Barns that are trailering back and forth each day may park their truck/trailer in the day parking area (next to the warm-up ring) during the show.

Vehicles parked in unauthorized areas or without appropriate parking permit may be towed at the owners expense. No parking is allowed in front of the barn area or along the road. The Barn Parking is behind barns 1-5. You must have a Barn Parking permit to park in this area.

REGIONAL CLASSES: These classes are open to any owner and exhibitor who resides outside of Kentucky in one of the 14 UMH designated regions (see the UMH Rule Book). Horses shown in regional classes can be trained in any state, including Kentucky, but must be owned and exhibited by someone who resides outside of Kentucky.

Regional classes are AAA Regional High Point classes and include:

- Class 1 – Regional Youth 17 & Under Trail Pleasure (MON AM)
- Class 3 – Regional Youth 17 & Under Classic Pleasure (MON AM)
- Class 19 – Regional Country Trail Pleasure (TUE AM)
- Class 21 – Regional Men’s Trail Pleasure (TUE AM)
- Class 50 – Regional Trail Pleasure (WED AM)
- Class 63 – Regional Amateur Trail Pleasure (WED AM)
- Class 65 – Regional 2 & Older Open In-Hand (WED PM)
- Class 68 – Regional Amateur Classic Pleasure (WED PM)
- Class 75 – Regional Ladies Trail Pleasure (WED PM)
- Class 93 – Regional Classic Pleasure (THU PM)

PROTESTS: Pursuant to UMH Rule 2.4, all allowable protests must be:

1. submitted in writing;
2. must cite the section of the Rules alleged to have been violated;
3. must describe the relevant circumstances and supporting facts, including the names of any witnesses, when the complainant became aware of such fact;
4. and, must be signed by the complainant, or Responsible Party listed on the entry form in the case of a Youth

A protest must be submitted no later than 30 minutes after the class in which the incident occurred in connection with; or 30 minutes after the complainant became aware of the facts supporting the protest. In any case, a protest can be submitted no later than 30 minutes after the last class of the competition.

Protests must be submitted with cash or a check for \$100 made payable to UMH, Inc. The \$100 will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

RULES TO REMEMBER:

- Helmets are required for all youth exhibitors age 11 and under. All individuals competing before their 18th birth date are required to wear an ASTM approved helmet when showing any age horse in hand.
- Cross-entry is prohibited during the entirety of the UMH World Show. Please note that the Breeders' Cup is a separate show.
- For in-hand classes, Arabian style halters are deemed as English in style. Mares, geldings and stallions may be presented in a show halter, bitless bridle or bridle and bit.
- Tack and attire may be English or Western but not a combination of both (exception: Western attire is required in all Western classes). English attire requires tie-downs for your pants legs. Refer to the current Rule Book for tack and attire requirements.
- A three minute clock will begin when the announcer calls the class. Requests for tack changes must be made before the start of the session and must be approved by the show manager. Tack changes will only be permitted for horses or riders in back-to-back classes.
- Entries are allowed up to ten minutes for a time out during a class for tack breakage or repair. All riders must request a time-out from the ringmaster by riding to the center of the arena. No assistant or groom may enter the ring until the time-out is approved and the announcement is made. Entries are allowed up to seven minutes for a thrown shoe. No one can pick-up the shoe other than a ringmaster. The seven minute time begins when the farrier picks up the foot to re-shoe the horse.
- In driving classes, a neatly attired header is required in the ring at the line-up and is allowed to unfasten the check rein and wipe the horse off, but shall not hold the horse or touch the horse for any other reason, unless permitted by the judge(s) or ringmaster.
- Gloves are mandatory in Equitation and Driving classes.
- When a dismount is called, an attendant may enter the ring when called by the ringmaster to hold only the off side stirrup when the exhibitor is ready to re-mount. The attendant may not touch the horse for any reason, unless permitted by the judge(s) or ringmaster.
