2. DQP will be paid at rate of \$175.00 per day for a total fee of \$ _____. The fee is due and payable upon satisfactory completion of the DQP Inspection services under this Contract.
3. DQP and Show Manager/Sponsor both understand that DQP is an independent contractor, and is in no way considered an employee of the Show Manager/Sponsor, or Show. No federal, state, FICA, Medicare, or any form of tax will be withheld from the DQP's fee. It is the responsibility of the DQP to pay any required taxes.
4. Show Manager/Sponsor, initial all that apply.
 - _____ Sponsor will reimburse DQP for round trip mileage from DQP's place of residence to the horse show location or airport at the rate of \$.40 per mile. *** DQP will travel in the most cost conservative method available (airline or by car).
 - _____ Sponsor will provide _____ nights hotel lodging.
 - _____ Sponsor will provide or reimburse DQP for up to \$24.00/day per diem for meals.
 - _____ Sponsor will reimburse DQP for airline travel up to and not exceeding the amount of \$ _____ (DQP will procure lowest priced available coach fare).
 - _____ Sponsor will reimburse DQP for car rental expenses up to and not exceeding the amount of \$ _____ (DQP will procure lowest priced economy rental car).
 - _____ Other (Specify, e.g. airport parking fees up to \$12/day) _____.
5. DQP's failure to maintain status and standards as a licensed UHP DQP is cause for termination of this contract. This Contract shall be null and void if said Show is not held. In the even of cancellation or termination of this Contract for cause, DQP shall not be entitled to any compensation.
6. DQP releases Sponsor, Manager, any officers and members from all claims for any damage, losses, or injury to person or property of DQP or anyone accompanying the DQP to the show.
7. This Contract is binding upon the signature of both parties below.
8. DQP Director will not be held liable for nonpayment by show management.
9. DQP agrees to mail a complete DQP Inspection report, show records and tickets written to the UHP Director of DQP's within 48 hours of the conclusion of the show.
